BILLFISH 2005  
WINNERS**

Hatterascal took top honors at MarineMax-Hatteras Billfish Invitational last May. Captained by Terry Stansel, the Hatteras won the event presented by Raymarine that took place in Marsh Harbour, the Bahamas. The team, which got off to a slow start, came from behind on the third day of fishing to beat 21 other teams to win first prize. Second place went to Stanley Ginsberg of *Coco Loco*, a 67' Bertram, while third place was awarded to *Double Eagle* with Warren Potter leading his team. Top male angler went to *Coco Loco* team member David Ginsberg, and Alexis Jacobs of *Reel Obsession* won top lady angler award for her blue marlin catch from onboard her 70' Hatteras.

"The weather cooperated, and we had a great tournament," MarineMax's Shannon McCoy said. "The involvement with Make-A-Wish Foundation, along with the fun and social atmosphere of the tournament, provided a great time for everyone who participated. **EXTENDED MODEL HATTERAS 77'**

The new Hatteras 77' Convertible, which was previously a 75' (see *Yachts International* May 2005), will appeal to both cruisers and sportfishermen thanks to its extended interior layout, which was requested by 75' owners.

"We extended the 75' by nearly two feet to allow more space for the master suite and crew quarters," Hatteras' David Ritchie said. "This will create more options in the master such as an office, entertainment lounge and walk-in closets. The main deck saloon and galley will benefit from the length increase as well."

Accommodations are for eight in four ensuite staterooms. The 77' is built on a solid-fiberglass hull with Divinycell coring in the decks, bulkheads and hullsides above the waterline. She has a 22' beam and a shallow draft of 5'3". Deep propeller tunnels allow the large props to be tucked closer to the hull bottom, improving efficiency and reducing draft. According to Hatteras, the 77' is projected to reach a top speed of 37 knots and cruise at 30 knots, depending on the owner's engine selections.
